Bolton NHS Foundation Trust has a dedicated School Aged Immunisation Team made up of highly skilled staff who are experienced in offering vaccinations to all high school aged children in Bolton.

What vaccinations should I expect my child to receive this term?

From September 2024 to January 2025, the Immunisation Team will be offering the Tetanus, Diphtheria, Polio and Meningitis ACWY Vaccinations to all pupils in Year 10.

What do I need to do?



All pupils should now have received a consent form through school to take home. If you have not yet returned the consent form, please can this be returned in the envelope provided on your child's return to school from the October Half Term, so we can ensure that they receive their vaccinations on the dates we have booked in school.

Please can you return the consent form to school, even if you do not want your child to receive these vaccinations, so we can update our records

Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) Vaccinations



The Immunisation Team will also be offering the MMR Vaccination to any young person in Years 7 - 13 who may be incomplete with these vaccinations.
